To provide and connect military families to community resources in Northside Independent School District and JBSA (Joint Base San Antonio).

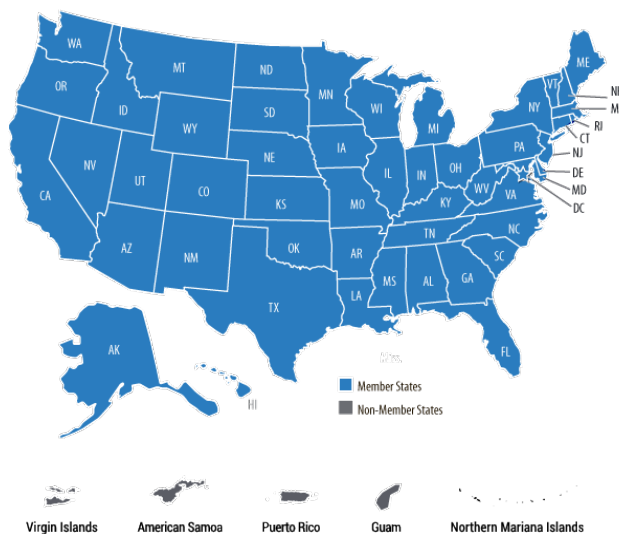

- Graduation requirement support
- Transfer of educational and enrollment records
- Eligibility for enrollment
- Placement and attendance

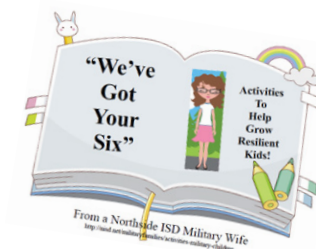
